
AT THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY MUSEUM IN REDLANDS

PROGRAMS ESPECIALLY FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN AGES 3 TO 12

Saturday Sept. 25, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. **GEOLOGY ROCKS!** Sort and classify rocks like geologists do. Learn about rocks, minerals and the earth, and take home rock collection record cards to start or advance your own collection. See spectacular specimens up close and make your own pet rock to top off your visit. Geology activities are included with paid museum admission.



Sunday October 3, 1 to 5 p.m. **FOSSIL REPLICA PAINTING.** Join artist Terry Long and learn how to paint a plaster fossil replica to make it look like the real thing! This Family Fun Day blending art and science is supported by a grant from the James Irvine Foundation; all activities are included with paid museum admission. Wear your painting clothes!



Saturday October 16, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. **WEAVING & STRING ART.** Beginners and experienced weavers will have fun with different weaving activities. Weave a bookmark or some art to display. Sew a fascinating geometric pattern using string, in one or a multitude of colors. Try out a real loom and weave additions to what has been woven so far. This program is supported with funding from the Western Textile Center Association; all activities are included with paid museum admission.

Saturday, October 23, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. **BIRDS OF A FEATHER.** A super-duper Family Fun Day, packed with avian activities for all ages. Learn more about our feathered friends as you have fun investigating feathers, flight, and adaptations. Draw birds in the land and water bird galleries at 10AM, 1PM, and 3PM. Visit the bird cart to meet some of your favorite birds up close. Make bird flip books and fold some bird origami. Try some birdwatching in the museum courtyard and gardens. All birds, all day! Activities are included with paid museum admission.



Saturday, November 6, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. **SERRANO TOYS, TOOLS, AND WEAPONS.** Play with authentic Native American toy replicas as you learn about the local Serrano Indian people. Use a non-electric pump drill to make a hole in leather. Enjoy demonstrations of rabbit sticks and spear-throwing. Play Serrano games and make one to take home. Activities are included with paid museum admission.
